The Little Pebble Books is a children's emotional support program founded by Trish Iiams — author, illustrator, foster mother, and adoptive parent. Every book, kit, and tool in this program was built from lived experience, not research alone.

The program combines gentle picture books, comfort kits, CASEL-aligned curriculum, regulation tools, and printable resources into one ready-to-use system — designed to help children feel safe, seen, supported, and ready to learn.

THE CARE PROGRAM

The Care Program is how The Little Pebble Books places kits in the hands of children who cannot afford them — funded entirely by donations and sponsorships, with no overhead markup. Every dollar donated goes directly to kit production and placement.
